# Readings from the Scriptures... Proverbs 18:23 – 19:4

These proverbs observe misfortune from various angles. The poor are reduced to begging and taking abuse (18:23), but a few friends stick by a man even in his worst times (18:24). The great majority of one's companions, however, only stay close by so long as one's fortunes are good; in bad times, they disappear (19:4). Poverty with integrity is better than immorality (19:1), but hunger, such as is produced by poverty, can lead to thoughtless, hasty acts of folly (see 19:2 and note). People often blame God for their misfortune when they should be blaming themselves. (ESV Study Bible)
