Readings from the Scriptures...

Proverbs 19: 15-23

Verses 15, 24-29, and 20:1 give a description of the life of the lazy, sluggard, and scoffer / mocker who can be summed up as the quintessential fool which are contrast with the essential features of a good life in verses 16-23. Proverbs teaches the good life as one who listens to instruction, is kind to the poor (those who lack opportunity), is involved in children's lives and disciplines them, avoids friendships with those who lack self-control, acknowledges the rule of God, understands that love and integrity are what brings real happiness, and fears the Lord. Conversely, laziness leads to dire poverty, the sluggard is so foolish he will not even feed himself, and the scoffer / mocker is a complete reprobate who doesn't respond to correction, no respect for parents, will not listen to sound teaching, rejects all notions of right and wrong, and gets beaten for his behavior.
